- abhainn a tha ag innse mun sgudal a tha a' milleadh nàdur.
- bùth a tha ag innse mun “credit crunch”!

Beagan cuideachaidh

Thoir sùil gheur air an dealbh. Smaoinich mu deidhinn. Feuch air nas urrainn dhut de fhiosrachaidh faighinn bhon dealbh. Sgrìobh notaichean mu na rudan a chì thu, agus air beachdan a thig gu d' inntinn.
