I was quite embarrassed about giving Pip chocolate biscuits and grapes to eat, no wonder he was miserable! I had no idea penguins like fish and squid!

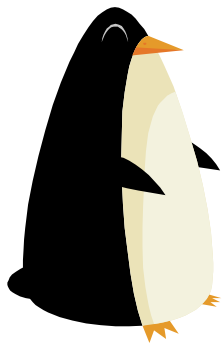
