- 4. What are Scotland's national, local and community traditions? What traditions exist in your local area?

Follow-up discussion (facilitate discussion around these questions after the learners have completed the activities)

- 2. What images or aspects of life in Scotland came up in your interview?
- 3. In what ways are your life and experiences similar to those of your interviewee? In what ways are they different?
- 4. Did anything your interviewee said make you think differently about your own life and experiences, or about your local traditions?
