Discussion questions

- 1. What do you think will happen next?
- 2. What *could* happen next between these two families?
- 3. What should happen between these two families?
- 4. What should Ania do? Why?
- 5. What should Rab do? Why?

Follow-up discussion (facilitate discussion around these questions after the learners have completed the activities)

- 1. As you read through *Walk The Walk*, what captured your attention or imagination (which character, storyline, scene)? Why?
- 2. In what ways does the book reflect people's real lives, identities, relationships and worlds?
- 3. In what ways does the book reflect your own experiences?
- 4. Have you learned anything from reading the book and/or completing the exercises?
- 5. Has the book made you think or feel differently about anything? If so, what, and why?
